Considering the serious nature of COVID19 (Coronavirus) pandemic, ISGL Board of Directors has been very closely monitoring the local and international conditions to ensure the safety of our mosque and community.

Due to the above concerns, all additional activities at ISGL are being suspended till further notice. Specifically, these suspended activities include Friday halaqas, Al Rahma Sunday School, adult and children Quran classes and any other up-coming already scheduled programs. Suspension of some of these services will become essential if there aren't enough volunteers to safely and effectively run them without creating serious logistical issues.

Please note that regular 5-daily prayers and Jumma (Friday) prayers will continue as per normal schedule as of now.

At the same time, we remind our community members that if you have traveled internationally, or have been extensively traveling within the country, out of abundance caution, please refrain from coming to the masjid for a period of 14 days. If you experience cold like symptoms, please immediately consult your medical care provider and follow their advice. These instructions comply to general guidelines being set by the government and major organizations.

InshaAllah, we will be sending periodic updates to the community and hope that situation takes a positive turn soon.
